Government Resolution

Shri Anil Madhav Dave, Minister of State (Independent Charge) in the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change has given a notice of the following Resolution which has been admitted:

"That this House approves the proposal of Government to reject the Award given on 16.4.1998 by the Board of Arbitration in C.A. Reference No.1 of 1992 in respect of allocation of higher pay scale of Rs.1400-2300, with effect from 20.06.1991, as against the then existing scale of Rs.1200-2040 to the post of Photographer in Botanical Survey of India (BSI), in terms of Para 21 of the Scheme for Joint Consultative Machinery and Compulsory Arbitration, on consideration of equity and economy, and in view of recommendation of the 5th Central Pay Commission as the implementation of the Award will create an anomalous situation in BSI, as the pay scale of Photographer of BSI will become the same as that of Senior Photographer of BSI, the promotional post for Photographer which would also inevitably lead to demand for higher pay scale for the post of Senior Photographer of BSI, and, in turn, from similar categories of staff in other organizations."
