INVITES SUGGESTIONS OF PUBLIC ON RUBBER INDUSTRY IN INDIA

The Department Related Parliamentary Standing Committee on Commerce, headed by **Dr. Chandan Mitra, M.P., Rajya Sabha** has taken up the subject of “**Rubber Industry in India**” for examination.

2. The Committee has decided to invite views/suggestions/comments from individuals/experts/institutions/organizations/stake-holders interested in the subject matter. The views/suggestions/comments may, *inter alia*, focus on issues like measures to realize the true potential of rubber sector in the country; production of various types of rubber in the country and demand-consumption pattern thereof; assistance/ support/ facilities/ incentives available to the Indian producers/ exporters/ importers/ manufacturers in rubber sector, deficiencies in the present policy/regulatory framework to enhance production and consumption of rubber; export potential of rubber and rubber products and the quality of government intervention in this regard; extant duty structure and other fiscal measures regulating the rubber sector; impact of various Free Trade Agreements on rubber growers/manufactures and rubber industry *per se*; efficacy of the Price Stabilization Fund Scheme; constraints afflicting the optimal growth of rubber-based industry; prevalent
