#### **SUMMONS**

Summons for the Two Hundred and Thirtieth Session of the Rajya Sabha was issued to the Members on the 13<sup>th</sup> of November, 2013.

#### **DURATION OF THE SESSION**

The Two Hundred and Thirtieth Session of the Rajya Sabha was held in two parts. The first part commenced on the 5<sup>th</sup> of December, 2013 and the House, which was earlier scheduled to adjourn on the 20<sup>th</sup> of December, 2013, adjourned *sine die* on the 18<sup>th</sup> of December, 2013. The second part of the Session commenced on the 5<sup>th</sup> of February, 2014 and the House adjourned *sine die* on the 21<sup>st</sup> of February, 2014, as scheduled. The House, in all, sat for 22 days and actual hours of sittings were 27 hours and 52 minutes (excluding recess intervals). The House was prorogued by the President on the 27<sup>th</sup> of February, 2014.

In this connection, I would like to refer to the terms of reference contained in the motion to constitute the Joint Committee, which was adopted by this House on the 1<sup>st</sup> of March, 2011. There is no provision in the Rules which permits discussion or raising of objections **before** laying of a Report which has been duly adopted by a Joint Parliamentary Committee.

I am, therefore, not inclined to allow any debate at this stage of laying of the Report of the Joint Committee."

(ii) On the 7<sup>th</sup> of February, 2014, the Chairman made the following observation:—

"Hon'ble Members, for several days, now, we have been in a situation of being forced to witness deviations from the decorum of the House by people coming into the Well and shouting slogans. I wish to inform the Hon'ble Members that this will precisely be reflected in the proceedings of the House.

This morning, two issues have been mentioned, by the Hon'ble Members, on which they want a discussion. One is the situation arising out of the unfortunate incident relating to a student from the North-East and the other is about the Tamil Nadu fishermen. The Chair has no difficulty in accepting notices for discussion on both of these subjects. I would request the concerned Members to give appropriate notices".


