PRIVATE MEMBERS' LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS

Bills for introduction

1. SHRI K. K. RAGESH to move for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Constitution of India. *The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2017 (Insertion of new article 21B).*
ALSO to introduce the Bill.
2. SHRI V. VIJAYASAI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill to regulate the acceptance of unsolicited proposals from the private sector through Swiss challenge method of procurement in respect of infrastructure projects in the country and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. *The Privately Financed Infrastructure Projects (Regulation of Swiss Challenge Method of Procurement) Bill, 2017.*
ALSO to introduce the Bill.
3. SHRI V. VIJAYASAI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill to protect individual liberty, right of association, movement and bodily integrity and the right of adults to choose their own partners in marriage and to prevent victimisation by prohibiting unlawful assemblies and other conducts interfering with matrimonial alliances in the name of honour and tradition and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto. *The Prevention of Crimes in the Name of Honour and Tradition and Prohibition of Interference with the Freedom of Matrimonial Alliances Bill, 2017.*
ALSO to introduce the Bill.
4. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the removal of hunger and malnutrition and for the prevention of starvation deaths of tribal children including adolescent and young girls and pregnant and lactating women in tribal areas of the country particularly in Maharashtra through a nodal agency at the National and State levels, by formulating a National policy for the purpose and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto. *The Tribal Children and Lactating Women in Maharashtra and Other States (Removal of Hunger, Malnutrition and Prevention of Starvation Deaths) Bill, 2017.*
ALSO to introduce the Bill.

The Water Scarce Regions of Marathwada, Vidharbha, Bundelkhand and in Eastern and Southern Parts (Prohibition of Growing Water Intensive Crops and Setting up of Thermal Power Plants and Other Large Scale Water Intensive Industries) Bill, 2017.

5. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the prohibition of growing water intensive crops and setting up of thermal power plants and other large scale water intensive industries in water scarce regions of Marathwada, Vidharbha, Bundelkhand and such other regions in eastern and southern parts of the country and for the promotion of growing less water consuming crops particularly those developed by Indian Council of Agricultural Research and such other bodies and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2017 (Insertion of new article 24A).

6. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Constitution of India.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

The Labour (Welfare and Rehabilitation) Bill, 2017.

7. SHRI VIVEK GUPTA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to establish a Labour Welfare and Rehabilitation Authority to look into the dynamic trends in the labour market, provide for schemes to give interest free loans to workers unemployed for certain periods, issue guidelines for social sector schemes including universal basic income for all working in private and public sector, provide for wages during non-work time for seasonally employed workers, provide for hardship bonus for plantation workers, formulate schemes for rehabilitation of workers of closed industries and for all matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

The Women (Empowerment and Welfare) Bill, 2017.

8. SHRI VIVEK GUPTA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to establish a Women Empowerment and Welfare Authority to provide for monthly incentive schemes for girl children to delay marriage until the age of twenty one years, special saving schemes for women with higher rate of interest inclusive of annual bonus if husband is non-alcoholic, special fund for micro credit schemes, guidelines for mobile healthcare facilities for agricultural labour, regulation of private placement agencies, schemes for widows and for all matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

The Gymnasiums and Fitness Centres (Regulation) Bill, 2017.

9. DR. T. SUBBARAMI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for regulation and control of gymnasiums and fitness centres which are engaged in activities, such as giving training on weight lifting and body building and conduct courses for weight reduction and proper nutrition in the country and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

Bills for consideration and passing

10. FURTHER CONSIDERATION of the following motion moved by Shri B. K. Hariprasad on 7th April, 2017:—

"That the Bill further to amend the Constitution of India, be taken into consideration."

SHRI B. K. HARIPRASAD to move that the Bill be passed.

SHRI PRADEEP TAMTA to move that the Bill to provide for the setting up of a Council to be called the Central Himalayan States Development Council to formulate development plans and schemes and also to monitor their implementation for the balanced and all-round development of the hilly States comprising the Central Himalayan region and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto, be taken into consideration.

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

12. SHRI VEER SINGH to move that the Bill further to amend the Constitution of India, be taken into consideration.

The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2015 (amendment of articles 341 and 342).

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

13. DR. K.V.P. RAMACHANDRA RAO to move that the Bill further to amend the Constitution of India, be taken into consideration.

The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2016 (amendment of articles 109, 117, 198 and 207).

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

14. SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR to move that the Bill to provide for effective regulation of the level of arsenic in ground water and identification of the risk areas of arsenic contamination, formulate a national policy for mitigating and preventing arsenic contamination in food and drinking water in the country for the overall welfare, care and protection of the citizens and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto, be taken into consideration.

**The Arsenic Contamination (Prevention) Bill, 2017.*

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

15. SHRI PRABHAT JHA to move that the Bill further to amend the Constitution of India, be taken into consideration.

The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2017 (Amendment of article 51A).
