PRIVATE MEMBERS' LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS

*Bills for introduction*

*The Labour  
(Welfare and  
Rehabilitation) Bill,  
2017.*

1. SHRI VIVEK GUPTA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to establish a Labour Welfare and Rehabilitation Authority to look into the dynamic trends in the labour market, provide for schemes to give interest free loans to workers unemployed for certain periods, issue guidelines for social sector schemes including universal basic income for all working in private and public sector, provide for wages during non-work time for seasonally employed workers, provide for hardship bonus for plantation workers, formulate schemes for rehabilitation of workers of closed industries and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

2. SHRI VIVEK GUPTA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to establish a Women Empowerment and Welfare Authority to provide for monthly incentive schemes for girl children, to delay marriage until the age of twenty one years, special saving schemes for women with higher rate of interest inclusive of annual bonus if husband is non-alcoholic, special fund for micro credit schemes, guidelines for mobile healthcare facilities for agricultural labour, regulation of private placement agencies, schemes for widows and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

*The Women (Empowerment and Welfare) Bill, 2017.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

3. SHRI VIVEK GUPTA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to establish an Urban Areas Equitable Development Authority to provide for clean, hygienic maintenance of environment and public spaces, resettlement of people living in slums in decent housing facilities, issuing guidelines for employment of people in slums in the reconstruction activities, facilitating system of self policing among citizens, proper underground drainage and sewerage network, dedicated paths for pedestrians and cyclists, formulate policies for subsidising cycles and promoting eco-friendly transport, creation of community markets for hawkers and their resettlement in metro stations and subways, issuing licenses to hawkers, providing for minimum standards to be maintained by private hostels and paying guest accommodations and recommending their compulsory registration, framing guidelines for ensuring equal redistribution of economic and work opportunities in urban areas and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

*The Urban Areas (Equitable Development and Regulation) Bill, 2017.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

4. SHRI K. T. S. TULSI to move for leave to introduce a Bill to protect the human rights of persons affected by leprosy, to eliminate discrimination against them and their families, to promote their social welfare, to take steps for the prevention and control of leprosy and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

*The Rights of Persons Affected by Leprosy and Members of their Family (Protection Against Discrimination and Guarantee of Social Welfare) Bill, 2017.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

5. DR. VINAY P. SAHASRABUDDHE to move for leave to introduce a Bill to promote conception, experimentation and implementation of educational innovations in the country by establishing the Educational Innovations Commission and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

6. SHRI V. VIJAYASAI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Constitution of India.

*The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2017 (insertion of new article 21B).*

*The Prevention of Enforced Disappearance Bill, 2017.*

7. SHRI V. VIJAYASAI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide punishment for enforced disappearance of any person by public servants or any person subjecting a person to an enforced disappearance with the consent or acquiescence of any public servant and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Prevention of Torture Bill, 2017.*

8. SHRI V. VIJAYASAI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide punishment for torture inflicted by public servants or any person inflicting torture with the consent or acquiescence of any public servant and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Compulsory Protection of Witnesses and Victims of Crimes Bill, 2017.*

9. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the compulsory protection of witnesses and victims of crimes by the State who are intimidated, harassed, physically attacked by various means or of their family members or their near and dear ones by the accused of crimes or by their accomplices or friends or relatives or co-accused or sympathizers committed either directly against the victims or against their family members or their near and dear ones and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Heritage Cities and Sites (Conservation and Development) Bill, 2017.*

10. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the conservation and development of heritage cities and sites by way of retaining their historical identification and promoting international and domestic tourism and publishing their historical importance through booklets, pamphlets and such other material and for declaring heritage cities as smart cities for overall development and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Environment Protection (Management of Landfill Sites and Control of Non-Biodegradable Garbage) Bill, 2017.*

11. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the formulation of a national policy to set up engineered landfill sites at conspicuous places away from human settlements, for their scientific management and for preparing a model solid waste management policy to prevent throwing or depositing non-biodegradable garbage or waste at public places such as roads, parks, public drains or places open to public view so as to protect the environment and ultimately mother earth from being polluted by such garbage or waste responsible for the climate change and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Flood and Drought Control Bill, 2017.*

12. DR. T. SUBBARAMI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the setting up of a National Flood and Drought Control Board to control flood and drought and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

13. DR. T. SUBBARAMI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill to regulate the functioning of play schools and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. *The Play Schools (Regulation) Bill, 2017.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

14. SHRI SUKHENDU SEKHAR RAY to move for leave to introduce a Bill to make provisions in relation to bail in connection with criminal proceedings in the country and to ensure protection of personal liberty of the citizens and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. *The Bail Bill, 2017.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

15. SHRI SUKHENDU SEKHAR RAY to move for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Constitution of India. *The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2017 (amendment of article 366).*

16. SHRI NARAYAN LAL PANCHARIYA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for making teaching of vedic education compulsory in educational institutions and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto. *The Vedic Education (Compulsory Teaching in Educational Institutions) Bill, 2017.*

17. SHRI NARAYAN LAL PANCHARIYA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the development and promotion of solar power generation and mandatory use of solar power in buildings with a view to saving conventional energy and protecting the environment and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. *The Solar Power (Development, Promotion and Mandatory Use) Bill, 2017.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

18. SHRI NARAYAN LAL PANCHARIYA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the constitution of judicial statistical authorities for collection and publication of judicial statistics and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto. *The Judicial Statistics Bill, 2017.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*Bills for consideration and passing*

19. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move that the Bill to provide for the protection of farmers from exploitation by moneylenders, middlemen, unscrupulous traders and others, removal of indebtedness, remunerative prices for their produce, increasing farm yield by improving farming practices by modern techniques and allied occupations, extending protective umbrella against natural calamities in which crops are lost by way of compulsory insurance of crops and livestock and provision of adequate compensation, work, food, potable water, fodder, etc. during calamity, extending compulsory market intervention in case of bumper crops, old age allowance, soft loans from Banks and other institutions and other welfare measures to be undertaken by the State so as to prevent the distressed farmers from committing suicide and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto, be taken into consideration. *The Exploited, Indebted and Poverty Stricken Farmers (Protection, Prevention of Suicides and Welfare) Bill, 2014.*

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

*The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2016 (insertion of new article 16A).*

20. SHRI VISHAMBHAR PRASAD NISHAD to move that the Bill further to amend the Constitution of India, be taken into consideration.

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

*\*The Children with Specific Learning Disabilities (Identification and Support in Education) Bill, 2016.*

21. SHRIMATI VANDANA CHAVAN to move that the Bill to identify and support the children with learning disabilities in education and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto, be taken into consideration.

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

*\*The Women's (Reservation in Workplace) Bill, 2016.*
