Bills for introduction

1. SHRI VIVEK GUPTA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to establish an Authority for Inclusive Development and Regulation of Education to provide for inclusion of traditional Indian knowledge, ancient Indian history, culture, civics, digital and financial education in the education curriculum, increase in their weightage in the syllabus, institution of compulsory qualifying paper, creating fund for promoting research on theories postulated in ancient texts, issuing guidelines to the Central and State Governments to make the education more inclusive, recommending to the Central Government for free and compulsory education at secondary and senior secondary level, formulating recommendations to the Central and State Governments for regulating fees in educational institutions and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

The Education (Inclusive Development and Regulation) Bill, 2018.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

2. SHRI VIVEK GUPTA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to establish a Medical Healthcare Universalisation and Regulation Authority to provide for realisation of the implied fundamental right of citizens to health and healthcare by recommending protection of rights of patients and doctors, making accessible and affordable healthcare for all by proposing universal health insurance, State-sponsored health insurance for people below the poverty line, regulation of medical fees and prices of stents, drugs and other life saving apparatus charged by private healthcare establishments, free medicines to people below the poverty line, regulation of establishment of private hospitals in metropolitan cities, monitoring of public health centers and Government hospitals and patients' complaints from Government hospitals, constitution of special courts to fastrack the medico-legal cases and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

3. SHRI VIVEK GUPTA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to establish an interstate, inter-institutional Ganga Rejuvenation Authority for the rejuvenation of the river Ganga, provide for realization of right to clean and healthy environment of millions of people who reside near river Ganga and whose livelihood depends on the river, to minimize the amount of sewage and industrial waste discharge, to ensure establishment of requisite infrastructure for sewage treatment alongwith the adoption of innovative practices for disposing the sewage, to provide for proper bathing infrastructure on the Ghats, and creation of small tanks containing the river water for the religious offerings and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.
