### PRIVATE MEMBERS' LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS

#### *Bills for introduction*

1. SHRI NARAYAN LAL PANCHARIYA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for universal health insurance and healthcare coverage to all citizens and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. *The Universal Health Insurance and Healthcare Coverage Bill, 2018.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

2. SHRI NARAYAN LAL PANCHARIYA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for an institutional mechanism for identification of illegal immigrants in the country and their deportation and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. *The Illegal Immigrants (Identification and Deportation) Bill, 2018.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

3. SHRI NARAYAN LAL PANCHARIYA to move for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Information Technology Act, 2000. *The Information Technology (Amendment) Bill, 2018.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

4. SHRI SANJAY SINGH to move for leave to introduce a Bill to make special provisions for the National Capital Territory of Delhi for a period upto the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March, 2020 and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. *The National Capital Territory of Delhi Laws (Special Provisions) Bill, 2018.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

5. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the protection of the families of farmers by the State who have lost their lives in accident of any nature, due to disease, natural death or by committing suicide by extending welfare measures, financial assistance etc. so as to enable the bereaved families to bear the loss of their bread winners and live a respectable life and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto. *The Protection of Farmers Families Bill, 2018.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Prevention of Contamination of Groundwater Bill, 2018.*

6. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the prevention of contamination of groundwater due to arsenic, fluoride, zinc and other mineral residues which adversely affect the health of millions of people for identification of risk areas of contamination, formulation of national policy for preventing contamination of groundwater and for the establishment of a Board for specifically concentrating on this issue so as to protect the people from adverse effects of water contamination and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Compulsory Yoga and Sports Education in Schools Bill, 2018.*

7. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for compulsory yoga and sports education from primary to senior secondary level in all the schools throughout the country in order to prepare talent of sports from school level and thereby ensuring good health of students and for making it obligatory for the Central and State Governments to provide requisite infrastructure for the purpose and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2018 (amendment of article 19).*

8. SHRI V. VIJAYASAI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Constitution of India.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Criminal Law (Amendment) Bill, 2018.*

9. SHRI V. VIJAYASAI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Agricultural and other Rural Workers (Protection and Welfare) Bill, 2018.*

10. SHRI AMAR SHANKAR SABLE to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the protective measures to the agricultural and other rural workers against exploitation and for ensuring minimum wages, pension, provident fund facilities and financial compensation with paid leave in case of accidents, medical, maternity and crèche facilities to women workers, education and nutrition for the children and such other welfare measures to be ensured by the State and for the establishment of a Welfare Authority and Welfare Fund for such workers of the rural areas and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Downtrodden, Backward and Oppressed Youth (Development and Welfare) Bill, 2018.*

11. SHRI AMAR SHANKAR SABLE to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the formulation and implementation of a comprehensive national policy for ensuring overall development of the youth belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and those from Other Backward Classes and oppressed categories from the religious and linguistic minorities and for their welfare to be undertaken by the State and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*Bills for consideration and passing*

12. SHRI P. L. PUNIA to move that the Bill to ensure speedy removal of social and economic disparity through targeted expenditure on special schemes for the welfare and development of the members of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Communities and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto, be taken into consideration.

*§ The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Sub Plans (Budgetary Allocation and Special Schemes) Bill, 2015.*

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

13. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move that the Bill to provide for the protection of farmers from exploitation by moneylenders, middlemen, unscrupulous traders and others, removal of indebtedness, remunerative prices for their produce, increasing farm yield by improving farming practices by modern techniques and allied occupations, extending protective umbrella against natural calamities in which crops are lost by way of compulsory insurance of crops and livestock and provision of adequate compensation, work, food, potable water, fodder, etc. during calamity, extending compulsory market intervention in case of bumper crops, old age allowance, soft loans from Banks and other institutions and other welfare measures to be undertaken by the State so as to prevent the distressed farmers from committing suicide and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto, be taken into consideration.

*The Exploited, Indebted and Poverty Stricken Farmers (Protection, Prevention of Suicides and Welfare) Bill, 2014.*

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

14. SHRI NARESH GUJRAL to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the establishment of an effective system to prevent and address the decline in productivity of Parliament due to disruptions of sittings, by means of an appropriate legal framework to fix the minimum number of days in a year for which Parliament shall be in Sessions, introduction of special Session in addition to the existing three Sessions, compensation for the hours unutilised due to disruptions, and to provide obligations of the Presiding Officers of both Houses and the Members of Parliament and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto, be taken into consideration.

*The Parliament (Enhancement of Productivity) Bill, 2017.*

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

15. DR. K.V.P. RAMACHANDRA RAO to move that the Bill further to amend the Constitution of India, be taken into consideration.

*The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2016 (amendment of articles 109, 117, 198 and 207).*

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

16. SHRI PRADEEP TAMTA to move that the Bill to provide for abolition of capital punishment in India, be taken into consideration.

*The Abolition of Capital Punishment Bill, 2016.*

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.
