### PRIVATE MEMBERS' LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS

#### *Bills for introduction*

1. DR. T. SUBBARAMI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill to amend the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006. *The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development (Amendment) Bill, 2018.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

2. DR. T. SUBBARAMI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Railways Act, 1989. *The Railways (Amendment) Bill, 2018.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

3. DR. T. SUBBARAMI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide employment or means and resources for self-employment atleast one adult member of every family and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto. *The Employment Bill, 2018.*

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

4. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for protection of the families of farmers by the State who have lost their lives in accident of any nature, due to disease, natural death or by committing suicide by extending welfare measures, financial assistance etc. so as to enable the bereaved families to bear the loss of their bread winners and live a respectable life and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto. *The Protection of Farmers Families Bill, 2018.*

*The Prevention of Contamination of Groundwater Bill, 2018.*

5. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the prevention of contamination of groundwater due to arsenic, fluoride, zinc and other mineral residues which adversely affect the health of millions of people and for identification of risk areas of contamination, formulation of national policy for preventing contamination of groundwater and for the establishment of a Board for specifically concentrating on this issue so as to protect the people from adverse effects of water contamination and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Compulsory Yoga and Sports Education in Schools Bill, 2018.*

6. SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for compulsory yoga and sports education from primary to senior secondary level in all the schools throughout the country in order to prepare talent of sports from school level thereby ensuring good health of students and for making it obligatory for the Central and State Governments to provide requisite infrastructure for the purpose and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Armed Forces (Special Powers) Repeal Bill, 2018.*

7. SHRI RIPUN BORA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to repeal the Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act, 1958.

*The Women (Equal Participation in International Peace Negotiations, Treaties and Agreements) Bill, 2018.*

8. SHRI RIPUN BORA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to ensure equal participation of women in representing the Government of India while entering into any international treaty, agreement, covenant, resolution or negotiation, including those relating to war and peace, in order to uphold the values of international human rights and convention to which India is a signatory and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

*The National Anthem (Modification) Bill, 2018.*

9. SHRI RIPUN BORA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to modify the National Anthem "Jana Gana Mana".

*The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2018 (amendment of articles 85 and 174).*

10. SHRI C. M. RAMESH to move for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Constitution of India.

ALSO to introduce the Bill.

*The Food Waste (Reduction) Bill, 2018.*

11. SHRI MAHESH PODDAR to move for leave to introduce a Bill to curb food waste by empowering and mobilizing food procedures, processors and distributors, consumers and associations and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

12. SHRI V. VIJAYASAI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. *The Code of Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Bill, 2018.*

VIKAS MAHATME to move for leave to introduce a Bill to develop a new method of implementing reservation policy through the weighted indexing system, to achieve social justice and reservation benefits to the most deserving individuals and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. *The Other Backward Classes (Sub-Categorization) Bill, 2018*

16. SHRI PARTAP SINGH BAJWA to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the establishment of an autonomous body, called the Safeguarding and Adjudicating Farmers' Economic Rights Commission, to help improve the economic conditions of farmers, reduce their indebtedness and for all matters connected therewith and incidental thereto. *The Safeguarding and Adjudicating Farmers' Economic Rights Commission Bill, 2018*

*Bills for consideration and passing*

17. Further consideration of the following motion moved by Shri Naresh Gujral on the 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2018:— *The Parliament (Enhancement of Productivity) Bill, 2017.*

“That the Bill to provide for the establishment of an effective system to prevent and address the decline in productivity of Parliament due to disruptions of sittings, by means of an appropriate legal framework to fix the minimum number of days in a year for which Parliament shall be in Sessions, introduction of special Session in addition to the existing three Sessions, compensation for the hours unutilised due to disruptions, and to provide obligations of the Presiding Officers of both Houses and the Members of Parliament and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto, be taken into consideration.

SHRI NARESH GUJRAL to move that the Bill be passed.

18. PROF. M. V. RAJEEV GOWDA to move that the Bill further to amend the Representation of the People Act, 1951, be taken into consideration. *The Representation of the People (Amendment) Bill, 2014*

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

19. SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD to move that the Bill further to amend the Constitution of India, be taken into consideration. *The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2016 (insertion of new article 21B).*

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

*The Arsenic Contamination (Prevention) Bill, 2017*

20. SHRI NEERAJ SHEKHAR to move that the Bill to provide for effective regulation of the level of arsenic in ground water and identification of the risk areas of arsenic contamination, formulate a national policy for mitigating and preventing arsenic contamination in food and drinking water in the country for the overall welfare, care and protection of the citizens and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto, be taken into consideration.

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

*The Companies (Amendment) Bill, 2018*

21. SHRI RIPUN BORA to move that the Bill further to amend the Companies Act, 2013, be taken into consideration.

ALSO to move that the Bill be passed.

*#The Special Financial Assistance to the Bundelkhand Region of the State of Uttar Pradesh Bill, 2016*

22. SHRI VISHAMBHAR PRASAD NISHAD to move that the Bill to provide for special financial assistance to the Bundelkhand region of the State of Uttar Pradesh for the purpose of promoting the welfare of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Minorities and poor farmers and for the development, exploitation and proper utilization of its resources and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto, be taken into consideration.
