Bills for introduction

1. DR. T. SUBBARAMI REDDY to move for leave to introduce a Bill to amend the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006. *The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development (Amendment) Bill, 2018.*

SHRI RAJKUMAR DHOOT to move for leave to introduce a Bill to provide for the prevention of contamination of groundwater due to arsenic, fluoride, zinc and other mineral residues which adversely affect the health of millions of people and for identification of risk areas of contamination, formulation of national policy for preventing contamination of groundwater and for the establishment of a Board for specifically concentrating on this issue so as to protect the people from adverse effects of water contamination and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.
