LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS

Bills for consideration and passing

The National Council for Teacher Education (Amendment) Bill, 2018.

1. FURTHER CONSIDERATION of the following motion moved by Shri Prakash Javadekar on the 26th July, 2018:—
